Grievance Resolve

Local 99 has successfully resolved grievance number 13-056. If you have transferred from a branch where you were NOT supplied your tools to a branch where you WERE supplied tools (Ekati, Fort McKay or Kearl) between May of 2012 to April of 2013 then you can expect some extra funds on your paycheck come August 1/2014. For every month (including partial months) that you worked at the branch where you supplied your own tooling you should receive \$50 (1/12 of the \$600 tool allowance at that time). This resolve is based on and follows the new language in 11.09 that was agreed to in the last round of negotiations.

If you believe you should be compensated as you fall under the requirements stated above, but you do not see the line item on your pay stub on the August 1st payday then please contact Ryan Ermet at rernet@iamaw99.ca
