You can only use a personal internet-capable device (no company supplied devices).

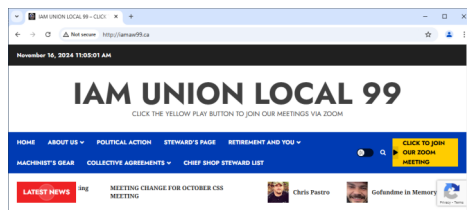
Every virtual participant must use their first and last name as their screen name.

Finning Main: The teams are back together the week of June 16-20 and are close to getting an agreement to roll out for the members.

Kal-Tire: There has been a delay in receiving a finalized memorandum from the employer which is creating frustration amongst the members, understandably so. It was also reported that there was zero communication from the employer. This was an overstatement as Kal did communicate on June 5th that they were still reviewing the materials. So while formal updates have been minimal, there have been intermittent communications.

Your teams remain ready to review and finalize the last remaining details and move toward presenting complete agreements to the members for ratification votes. They are all committed and appreciate your continued support.

More dates are coming for all 3 groups. We just need to be patient during this time as negotiations can take time for a good contract.

The next step, if we cannot finalize memorandums, would be to move directly to applying for Mediation with the Alberta Labour Board.
