## 2025 Finning Bargaining Committee Update

## To all Finning Members:

On Monday November 3rd the bargaining committee put a Freeze on the balloting process after recommendation from our legal council. The issue was a difference in opinion concerning the \$2.25 field premium parts people receive when they are in the field and if they are eligible for that premium. Today Finning committed to leaving the premium as currently being applied, until 2028 bargaining.

We took this pause to make sure that members continue to receive the field premium, and to protect the integrity of your CBA before the vote continues. Because of the rapid pace of these discussions we weren't able to communicate every detail immediately. While our initial notice to pause the vote was intentionally brief, we needed to inform members promptly, while also being tactful and ensuring information was accurate before sharing more details.

We have confirmed all members who applied to vote online with our master list. Tomorrow morning online voting will begin, all those who applied for an online ballot will receive an email confirming virtual voting is open, and an email with a personal link to vote from "simply vote". As soon as we can contact the administrator those who applied for the absentee ballot will have until midnight Friday November 7th, after that we will tally the votes and let the membership know the results. Depending on the outcome of the memberships vote we will communicate our next steps as soon as possible.
